Our Worthy Chaplain's Message

Dear Friends,

As we move through this blessed season, celebrating the solemnity of All Saints, honoring Veterans Day, giving thanks on Thanksgiving, and commemorating All Souls, the church invites us to see these liturgical moments as a single, powerful invitation to live out the first call to holiness that our Founder, Fr. Michael McGivney, envisioned for every member of our Order.

On October 6, Pope Leo XIV address to the Knights of Columbus invoked the intercession of Blessed Michael McGivney whose life was a concrete witness to the Gospel. By honoring him on the feast of all Saints we are reminded that sanctity is not a distant ideal, but a daily reality lived in the ordinary circumstances of family, work, and fraternal service. The Pope said:

Through a variety of initiatives undertaken by local Councils, you and your brother Knights seek to bring the compassion and love of the Lord into your local communities, including through your efforts to uphold the sanctity of human life in all its stages, to assist victims of war and natural disasters and to support priestly vocations. For these concrete actions, as well as for your daily prayers and sacrifices for the good of all God's people, I express sincerely my warm appreciation.

Welcoming the invitation of the Scriptures: "Be holy, because I am holy" (Lev 11:44) we recognize that the saints are the first fruits of the Kingdom; they show us that holiness is attainable for every layperson who walks in the light of Christ.

Commemorating Veterans Day, we recognize the dignity of those who bear arms in defense of peace. Our Patriotic value, prepares us to be witness of faith inspired by the Gospel: "Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called children of God" (Mt 5:9) the true Christian soldier fights not only with weapons but with the virtues of courage, charity, and fidelity to the Gospel. As Knights, we are called to pray for the physical and spiritual welfare of all who have served to support veteran's families, and to promote a culture of peace that reflects Christ's peace.

We are pilgrims of hope, and Pope Francis, in his 8 May 2024 General Audience, reminded the faithful that "hope is always linked to gratitude for God's providence". I encourage each Knight to make a personal act of thanksgiving this month, whether by feeding the hungry, visiting the elderly, or offering the Mass of gratitude for our departed brothers. Let us follow the Challenge by Supreme Chaplain Archbishop William E. Lori: "This month, I challenge you to learn more about the lives of the saints by selecting one or more to read about and then reflecting on how you can imitate his or her perseverance and hope".

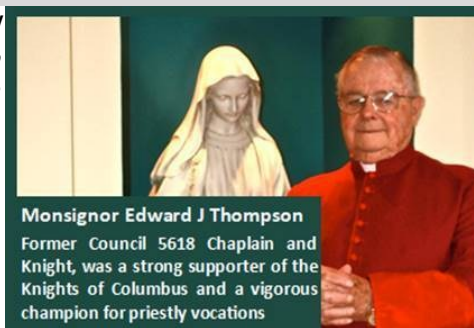
Vocations Fundraiser Results

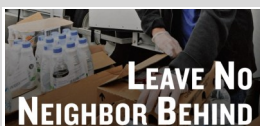
